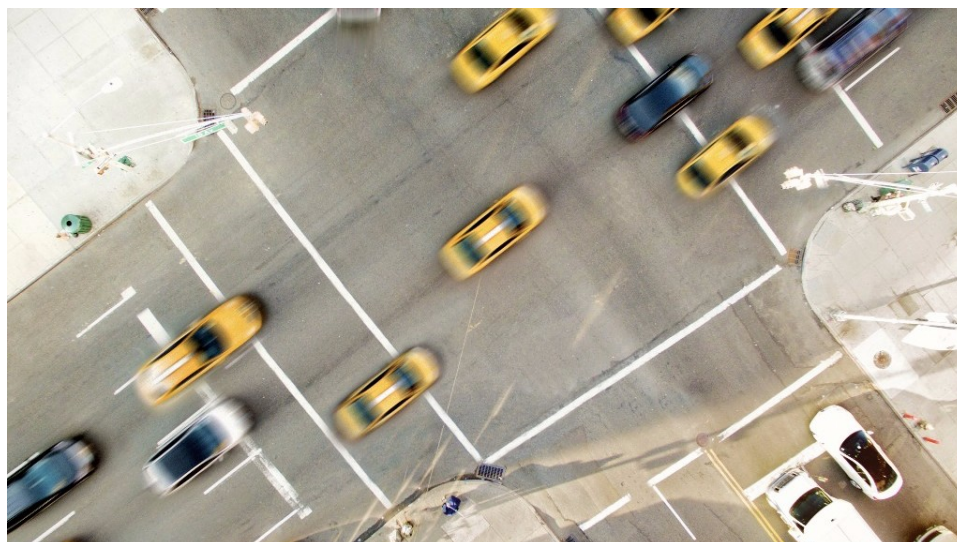


Spare the Air, Cool the Climate

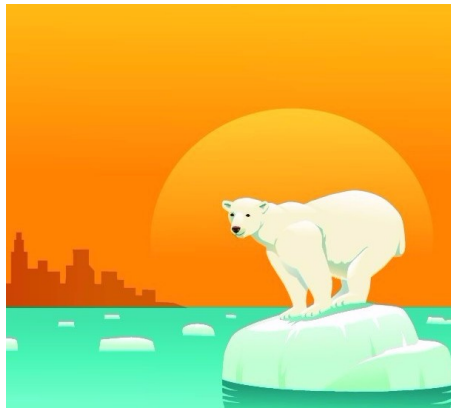
2017 Charge! Program
