This Advisory is provided to inform you that the Bay Area Clean Cars for All (CCFA) program is oversubscribed and is implementing a backup list.

## ATTENTION: CCFA Program Participants and Interested Stakeholders

## SUBJECT: Implementation of backup list for new applications

The CCFA program is oversubscribed, which means that it has received more applications than there is funding available. CCFA has implemented a backup list, effective immediately. The Air District is working to secure additional funding but currently does not anticipate receiving new funding in the near future.

Applications on a backup list may be considered for funding if previously submitted applications and awarded projects are cancelled, withdrawn, or fail to meet program requirements. Being on the backup list does not guarantee grant funding and priority may be given to Participants who live in disadvantaged communities that experience higher levels of air pollution as designated by <u>California Climate Investments</u>. If funding becomes available, applications will be moved off the backup list and Participants will be notified via email. Participants need to maintain program eligibility while on the backup list and staff may follow up for updated documentation when an application is moved off the backup list and reviewed.

Participants who submit an application before a backup list is implemented and are deemed eligible for the program after their application is reviewed will have funding reserved for their project. Funding will not be reserved for applications on the backup list. Active award letters may still be used and eligible Participants who purchase a plug-in electric vehicle (EV) can still apply for the EV charger incentive.

Depending on application backup list volumes, the program may close and stop accepting new applications for the backup list. There is no estimate for when a future program cycle will reopen at this time.
